INTRODUCTION:

TBAWA will attempt always to create a fun and competitive environment for junior players. This policy seeks to set the minimum expected standards of behaviour for TBAWA staff, volunteers, coaches and supporters, including parents. The Tenpin Bowling Association of WA is committed to excellence on and off the playing arena and to the overall health and well-being of all members.

This policy covers specific situations in which parents or guardians are in attendance at TBAWA sanctioned events (Including formal training) and the minimum expected standards of all associated adults

1. PARENT COMMITMENT:

As a parent or supporter of an Athlete in the sport of Tenpins in Western Australia, it is encumbered on parents and supporters to demonstrate being a positive member in our community, and a role model for all children. By choosing to travel with a State Team, attend local and state competitions and training it is expected from you the following.

To :

- Supportive my child's registration at with Tenpin Bowling Association of Western Australia
- Ensure my child adheres to his/her obligations under the Player's Code of Conduct signed by him/her, and acknowledge my own behaviour when participating or attending in my child's events
- Respect other parents, guardian's volunteers and other supporters that may be attending events that my child is participating in
- Not strike, swear, give alcohol or illicit substances to any child.
- Inform the Team Manager or a member of the committee as soon as possible of any observed breached or misconducted observed.
- Refrain from any form of abuse of both verbal or violent behaviour including threat towards any TBAWA athlete, volunteer, supporter or other parent.
- I will refrain from using social media and posting unwarranted comments about other children, the sport, TBAWA or any other member or supporter.
- Respect the rights and dignity and worth of all people regardless of gender, race, religious beliefs or abilities.

I acknowledge that;



1. While attending any sporting events (including training sessions) that my child is participating in including both local, state and international that I will adhere to all instructions/ directions of TBAWA Team Management including all other volunteers involved in the event.
2. Act respectfully and responsibly toward the players, coaches, club officials and other spectators of all teams.
3. A review of my behaviour and/or child's behaviour may be carried out by the TBAWA Board of Directors and may impose the following sanctions
 - Warnings, either verbal or in writing
 - Ejection from the bowlingcentre
 - Disciplinary action or exclusion imposed by the State Association or escalated to TBA Australia for membership or position review
 - Suspension or permanently removed from attending local events in the State of Western Australia.

2. BREACHES OF THIS POLICY

If a breach of any of this policy is brought to the attention to TBAWA Board of Directors, the individual will be met by the board to discuss behaviours and actions that were raised.

TBAWA shall access in the first instance the issue raises and all other relevant matters as considered important. TBAWA may impose penalties deemed necessary and warranted as required



3. DECLARATION TO SIGN

I acknowledge and accept all requirements outlined in this policy, including directions given to me by any TBAWA Board of Directors, subcommittees, Team Managers or Coaches.

I accept that breaches of the policy may carry consequences for my child.

I understand that sanctions may be imposed on my child and myself should either of us breach any aspect TBAL or TBAWA policies or procedures including this policy.
