	<ul> <li>Noted TBAWA lodged with DMIRS strategic 5 year plan last year. Note we have hit all milestones this year required by DMIRS.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Mia Buswell gave brief report on Bowl Patrol: which resulted in enhanced participation and increased funding for the State. Sports Schools throughout schools is a federally funded program through SportAus. Running 4 week program in schools and then progressing to Bowling Centres.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Local coaches, Ken Thompson, Chris Batson, Alvin Frost, Brett Marshall being utilised by Mike Diamond in setting up Training School which has been predominantly hosted by Warwick.</li> </ul>

- SportsWest HQ office facilities for hire costs \$1,200 per month on trial on a month by month basis.
- Bunbury Project continuation of Learn to Bowl package for high school students including disabilities and through TAFE, involving Isports in Bunbury, coaching provided, increasing membership overall in Bunbury.
- Tournaments have been registered for Carnival average for next year, feedback being received by members regarding format of events.

- Perth Ashes to be open event.
- Aust Day Singles to stay handicap event.
