## SELECTION CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION

### **ROSS BAILEY MEMORIAL AWARD**

This award is to recognise a volunteer amongst the bowling community that has dedicated their time continuously, to assist with a variety of tasks that has contributed to major events, programs, state teams and/or fundraising. This person is working behind the scenes unnoticed for the love of the sport. This award is given to an exceptional volunteer in memory of Ross Baily, who passed away a few years ago. Ross worked behind the scenes for events, tournaments, and leagues to make this sport special. His main centre was Cannington; however, he lent a hand where needed.

#### CRITERIA TO ASSESS NOMINEE FOR THIS AWARD

- Indicate the length of time volunteering (This can be outside of the nomination period for background purposes)
- Indicate the role and responsibilities the volunteer held
- Indicate the activities completed by the volunteer
- Indicate the Impact the volunteers time had on the community and/or sport
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Open to both male and female nominees

### **TBAWA COACH OF THE YEAR**

This award recognises significant achievements and dedication as a coach in Western Australia, and their activities they performed during the year.

- Must be a registered current coach recognised by TBAL
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Must have current membership

Open to both male and female nominees

### **TBAWA ATHLETE OF THE YEAR**

This award recognises significant performance by athlete at a national and/or international level. This award is presented to a high performing athlete that has shown a clear pathway to excellence and performed at the highest level representing their state and/or country.

- Indicate length of significant performance
- Must of competed at a national level minimum -and
- Must of made the National Training Squad in the year of nomination
- Indicate any international achievements
- Indicate any national or International team placements
- Indicate rankings from national and international if applicable
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Open to both male and female nominees
- Must have current membership

### **TBAWA SPORTS STARS AWARDS**

These awards are presented to an athlete that has competed at a state level with excellence in their division, or was successful in winning a place in the NTS or Australian Team, or an athlete that has shown a high standard of sportsmanship and/or is the best-est and fairest in their team in both training and competing at a state level.

#### **CRITERIA TO ASSESS**

- Indicate what state competition the nominee competed in and the outcome of this event or
- Indicate what national competition the nominee competed in and the outcome of this event
- Must have competed at a state level minimum
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Open to both male and female nominees
- Outline your recommendations and personal qualities that this nominee has displayed that should be recognised

### **TBAWA ROOKIE OF THE YEAR**

This award recognises a new bowler to the sport in this year that has improved from the beginning of the year and finished the season with excellence for a new competitor.

- Indicate how long they have been bowling in the sport
- Indicate what state competition, national, major tournament or significant event (300 game or high series) this nominee has achieved for this award
- Outline your recommendations
- Open to both male and female
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- No age restrictions

### **TBAWA JUNIOR BOWLER OF THE YEAR**

This award is presented to a junior bowler that has displayed excellence through the year both on and off the lanes

#### **CRITERIA**

- Must have competed at a National Level minimum
- Must not have attained the age of 18 by the 1<sup>st</sup> of January of the year of nomination
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Open to both male and female
- Outline your recommendations and personal qualities that this nominee has displayed that should be recognised

### **TBAWA YOUTH BOWLER OF THE YEAR**

This award is presented to a youth bowler that has displayed excellence through the year both on and off the lanes

- Must have competed at a national level minimum
- Must not have attained the age of 21 by the 1st of January of the year of nomination
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Open to both male and female
- Outline your recommendations and personal qualities that this nominee has displayed that should be recognised

### **TBAWA ADULT BOWLER OF THE YEAR**

This award is presented to an adult bowler that has displayed excellence through the year both on and off the lanes

- Must have competed at a national level minimum
- Must be over 18 of the year of nomination and events
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Open to both male and female
- Outline your recommendations and personal qualities that this nominee has displayed that should be recognised

### **TBAWA SENIOR BOWLER OF THE YEAR**

This award is presented to a senior bowler that has displayed excellence through the year both on and off the lanes

- Must have competed at a national level minimum
- Must be turning 50 of the year of nomination
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Open to both male and female
- Outline your recommendations and personal qualities that this nominee has displayed that should be recognised

### **TBAWA PERSONS WITH A DISABILITY BOWLER OF THE YEAR**

This award is presented to a disability bowler that has displayed excellence through the year both on and off the lanes

- Must have competed at a national level minimum
- Must meet the criteria defined as a person with a disability under the TBA guidelines
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Open to both male and female
- Outline your recommendations and personal qualities that this nominee has displayed that should be recognised

### **TBAWA MOST IMPROVED JUNIOR AWARD**

This award is for a junior bowler that has improved in both their physical and mental game whilst supporting their teammates. This nominee has shown a significant improvement in the ability and game.

- Must have shown a steady improvement over a minimum of 12 months
- Must not have attained the age of 18 by the 1st of January of the year of nomination
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Open to both male and female
- Outline your recommendations and personal qualities that this nominee has displayed that should be recognised

### **TBAWA MOST IMPROVED PERSONS WITH A DISABILITY AWARD**

This award is for a disability identified bowler that has improved in both their physical and mental game whilst supporting their teammates. This nominee has shown a significant improvement in the ability and game.

- Must have shown a steady improvement over a minimum of 12 months
- Must meet the criteria defined as a person with a disability under the TBA guidelines
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Open to both male and female
- Outline your recommendations and personal qualities that this nominee has displayed that should be recognised

### **CENTRE MANAGERS VOLUNTEER ACHIEVEMENT AWARD**

This award recognises the achievements and efforts a volunteer has made to a centre for the sport.

- Only nominations from an approved centre manager or assistant centre manager will be accepted
- Nominations from both Zone Bowling and Independent Centres are recognised

- Must have volunteered at the centre in activities that include, by not limited to, ball drilling, tournaments, events, coaching, community service within the centre, actively promoting the sport, giving assistance when asked of.
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Open to both male and female
- Outline your recommendations and personal qualities that this nominee has displayed that should be recognised
- No age restrictions

### **TBAWA & LEAGUE & VOLUNTEER ACHIEVEMENT AWARD**

This award recognises the efforts and time a volunteer or parent that has dedicated time to the sport as a volunteer for the whole state or a state team, or a centre, or participating in TBAWA hosted events and/or as a league member or centre voting delegate. These volunteers have participated and helped in, but not limited to Bowl Patrol Programs, Sporting Schools Programs, Managing State Teams, Fundraising, and/or League Management duties.

- Must have participated in at least one TBAWA, TBA, Bowl Patrol, Sporting Schools Program, State Team, League Representative / League Management team or Centre event as a volunteer
- Must be in good standing with the sport
- Open to both male and female
- Outline your recommendations and personal qualities that this nominee has displayed that should be recognised
- No age restrictions
