TBAWA HALL OF FAME POLICY 2021

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1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose

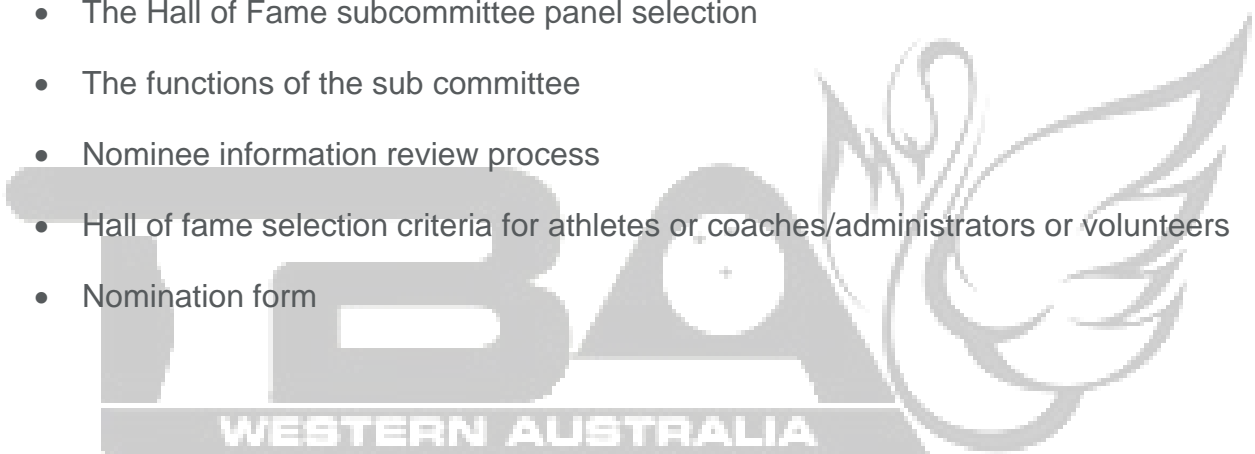
1.2 The purpose the Hall of Fame is to recognise those outstanding individuals who can be held up as role models for the sport of tenpin bowling in Western Australia.

Specifically, these outstanding individuals shall be recognised in one of two categories:

- Athletes who have demonstrated sustained performances at the highest levels in the sport of tenpin bowling; or
- Coaches/Administrators or Volunteers who have made an extraordinary, inspirational and dedicated personal contribution to tenpin bowling and its development.

1.3 Objectives

- The Hall of Fame subcommittee panel selection
- The functions of the sub committee
- Nominee information review process
- Hall of fame selection criteria for athletes or coaches/administrators or volunteers
- Nomination form



2 Hall of Fame Sub Committee

The Hall of Fame committee shall be a sub-committee of Tenpin Bowling Association of Western Australia Inc. and shall consist of:

- Three members to be selected from a pool of nominated persons. The members of the sub-committee may consist of current Tenpin Bowling Australia (TBA) members who are in good standing and/or members of the TBAWA Hall of Fame. All such persons will have the required knowledge, experience, competence and integrity to be part of an independent investigation process.
- All members of the nominated persons pool and the subsequent Hall of Fame sub-committee will be approved by the Board of Tenpin Bowling Western Australia (TBAWA)
- The chair of the sub-committee will be elected by the Board of TBAWA
- Minutes of all sub-committee meetings must be maintained and made available to the Board of TBAWA

It will be incumbent on all sub-committee members to declare that he or she has an association with a nominee (i.e. Through marriage, sibling, relative, de-facto, adoption, guardianship etc.) or any other conflict of interest not listed above.

2.1 The function of the Sub Committee

- Identify suitable nominee/s for either or both divisions for membership of the Hall of Fame.
- Accept nominations from members of TBA
- Examine nominees identified and gather sufficient information to ensure a fair assessment of their suitability for Hall of Fame membership
- Review the nominee information and request further information if it deems it is necessary
- Ensure that all information of nominees remain strictly confidential. Any breach of this shall result in the person being removed from the sub committee

3 Hall of Fame Selection Criteria

The selection criteria for Hall of Fame are divided into two categories.

- Athletes who have demonstrated outstanding performances at the highest levels in the sport of tenpin bowling.
- Persons who have made an extraordinary inspirational and dedicated personal contribution to tenpin bowling and its development in areas such as administration, coaching and volunteering in the sport and any other areas not already listed.
- Where a nominated individual has contributed significantly in both areas, they should be nominated in the category where their performance was most outstanding and their other contributions to the sport also listed on the official nomination form.

3.1 Athletes

Nominees must have an outstanding record in tournaments, locally, nationally and possibly internationally over a minimum of 15 years.

- Be or have been a member of Tenpin Bowling Australia (TBA) or its predecessor, the Australian Tenpin Bowling Congress (ATBC) and/or its affiliates during their involvement in the sport.
- Competed in Western Australian State Championships and/or represented Western Australia in National events.

3.2 Coaches/Administrators/Volunteers

Nominees must have made meritorious service contributions at State and/or National levels to the sport of tenpin bowling over a minimum of 15 years, including

- Outstanding contributions that have substantially advanced the sport
- Innovative or pioneering approaches to the organisation and management of tenpin bowling
- Dedicated personal contributions to tenpin bowling and its development beyond that normally expected
- Contributions that have substantially enhanced the reputation or profile of the sport
- Or any other criteria as determined by the Hall of Fame Sub Committee

3.3 Nominations

Nominations for Hall of Fame can be submitted from the 1st of January until the 30 September in the year of nomination.

This will allow the Hall of Fame sub-committee time to collate, review nomination/s and provide recommendations to the TBAWA Board. All questions please direct them the TBAWA Secretary at secretary@tenpinwa.org.

Submissions received outside the nomination period will be carried over to the following year.

- Potential inductees can only be nominated by a current financial member of TBA.
- All sections of the nomination form are to be fully completed with all relevant criteria included or attached.
- If no Hall of Fame nomination/s are received and/or deemed suitable, then no Hall of Fame induction will occur for that year.

Nomination forms will be accepted using the form provided in appendix 1, or via the online nomination form found on the TBAWA website at <https://www.tenpinwa.org>

Downloaded nomination forms once completed can be emailed to secretary@tenpinwa.org along with all relevant attachments/documents.

3.4 Disclaimer

Inductees into the Hall of Fame will remain members of the Hall of Fame, unless they are removed due to conduct prejudicial to the Hall of Fame and the good name of Tenpin Bowling Association of Western Australia Inc. (TBAWA) and the sport in general. The removal of any inductee from the Hall of Fame shall be in accordance with a resolution of the TBAWA Board.

4 Hall Of Fame Announcements

All Hall of Fame nominees will be contacted directly by the TBAWA association secretary and advised of their nomination.

All nominees will be invited to the Annual Tenpin Bowling Awards Night function where the winner/s will be announced.

All nominations will be announced on Tenpin Bowling Association of Western Australia Facebook page and the TBAWA website and other social media platforms.

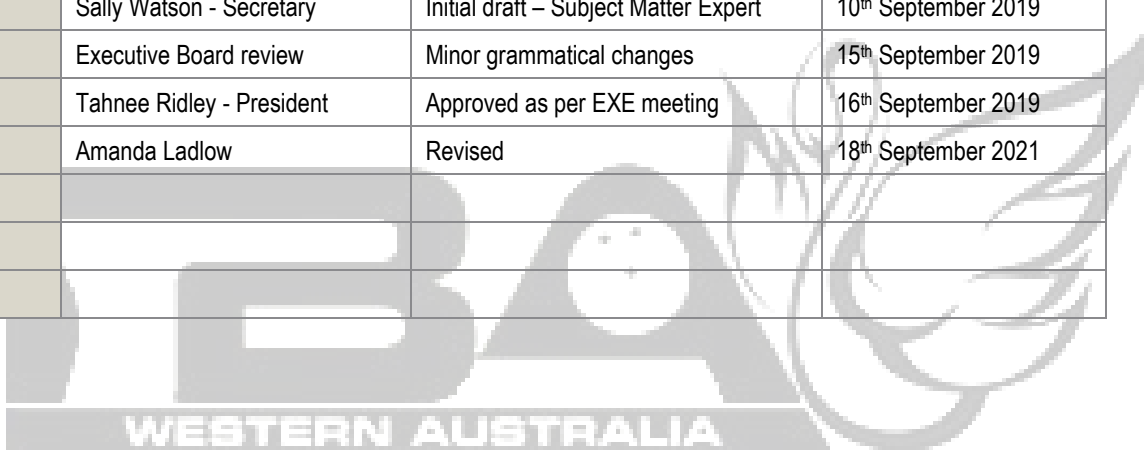
All winners will be placed on the Hall of Fame web page along with their biography.
